**ATR VERDICT:** Although MIDNIGHT CITY hasn't been at his best on turf recently, a return to the all-weather could spark an improved performance. Richard Spencer's charge finds himself well handicapped from a mark of 68 and a couple of his best efforts came in the returning cheekpieces. Blewburton is 2lb better off with his Kempton conqueror Ballsgrove Boy and the pair are likely to be closely matched again. Dutch Finale, who disappointed having been well supported on his seasonal return at Nottingham, could also step forward.

ATR VERDICT: Having returned to form with a good second over 2m at Bangor last month, LIPA K could be poised to strike. A 1lb rise in the ratings looks more than fair for the seven-year-old, and a return to 2m4f holds no fears. Little Sure Shot is out of a Group 3 winner who has already produced three nice winners.


