





The dual bumper scorer is unlikely to remain a maiden at this discipline for too long, and it'll be interesting to see if the addition of a tongue-strap can bring about some improvement. Back from a hurdling campaign, off a break, Jeaniemacaroney could prove more of a threat than the higher-rated Nelson Muntz.
