
**ATR VERDICT:** The only Willie Mullins/Paul Townend representative on this eight-race programme, COOLE CHERRY is the suggestion. Returning from a near nine-month absence, the seven-year-old was an easy winner at Kilbeggan last September and could prove nicely treated off a mark of 113. Cian Collins saddles Fiveonefive and Greatness Awaits, with both successful at the same Cartmel meeting last month. Previously trained in the UK, the latter starts off in Ireland and should give a good account of himself with a light weight on his back. On the mark when last seen at Tipperary and Ballinrobe respectively, Bitofajokelike and Winning Smut are sure to have plenty of supporters, while Zoffanien and My Gaffer are others for the shortlist in this competitive heat.
