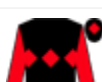
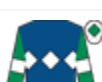

Breizh Sea is improving slowly with a third off this mark and he looks well handicapped after William Pyle's 3lb claim, while the consistent Highfield Viking appeals most of the remainder.

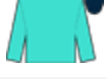
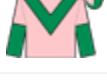

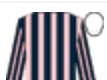

ATR VERDICT: With no form to go off, only a tentative vote goes to RELENTLESS HERO, who is a half-brother to Group 3 winner Yulong Gold Fairy. Andrew Balding's colt is well drawn in stall one and could make an instant impression. Attention Seeker is closely related to Shanghai Glory, who took Listed honours once in his career, and the son of Cotai Glory warrants a market check. Outspan is another to consider.
