ATR VERDICT: Blue Aria sets the form standard having finished fourth at Kempton on his debut, but it isn't a particularly daunting one and MONOCEROS gets the nod. The 750,000gns purchase is a full brother to the classy Al Suhail amongst others and represents a yard that typically does well here in such contests. I Can Dance is a half-brother to Dance In The Grass, who won her first two starts as a juvenile, so market support would be noteworthy.

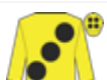
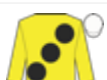
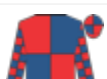

Second at Brighton in May, he missed the start, ran green and failed to handle the track, looking the sort to find plenty of improvement.
