ATR VERDICT: Kellebelle has been thereabouts in both of her appearances in handicap company, most recently finishing a respectable third at Huntingdon, and she is respected. Midnight Ginger competes off a career-low figure and could have a say, but LARGY PANIC went in by a neck over 2m at Kempton last month and can cope with this step back up in trip to complete a double.
