**ATR VERDICT:** Bottom-weight CHESTERBAYLAD has good claims after showing much-improved form on his second run back from a break. The well-related five-year-old raced close to the pace when second in a big field at Punchestown and may now be poised to strike. A maiden winner at Roscommon last summer, Laurie Blue was having her first run of the year when less than two lengths behind the selection in fourth at Punchestown and commands respect. I Feel Fine wasn't beaten far when sent off favourite at Limerick over Christmas. Although disappointing on his latest start, the Califet gelding may be capable of improvement on better ground.
