ATR VERDICT: With an official rating of 81, a race of this nature looks within FOZZIE's compass. The Kodi Bear gelding didn't appear to see out 1m2f at Pontefract recently and this emphasis on speed is sure to see him in a better light. Indefensible arrives on the back of a close-up second at Thirsk and he may serve the most resistance to the selection, ahead of the lighty-raced Bee Farmer.

ATR VERDICT: Anificas Beauty sprang a surprise when scoring over C&D at 66/1 and shouldn't be underestimated in her follow-up bid, while Little Ted arrives in good heart judged on his latest second at Musselburgh. However, the pair could be worth taking on with HOSTELRY, who was too far back when finishing fifth over track and trip 20 days ago. The veteran is effectively 6lb lower with Tom Kiely-Marshall's 5lb claim factored in and she ticks plenty of the right boxes.
