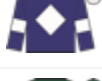

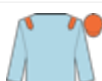
ATR VERDICT: PRINCE OF INDIA has been highly tried on his last two starts and may find dropping in class and trip comes at the right time. Having backed up a respectable sixth in the July Cup over C&D by filling the runner-up berth in the Hungerford at Newbury last weekend, he can strike with sights lowered. Elarak and Dubai Bling are feared the most from the older horses. However, Midnight Tango and Words Of Truth have rising profiles and could be bigger dangers if exploiting the weight-for-age allowance.

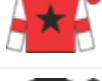
ATR VERDICT: With one eye on the Cesarewitch in October, GOBLET OF FIRE can cement his credentials with another bold showing on the Flat. Nicky Henderson's gelding won a heritage handicap on the Rowley Mile on his penultimate start and also ran a blinder to finish third over C&D in a similar event last month. Off just 2lb higher, the six-year-old has the most highly appealing profile. ATR VERDICT: Although ADONIUS lost his unbeaten record when second in the Molecomb at Glorious Goodwood, Rebecca Menzies' gelding emerged with lots of credit.
