ATR VERDICT: Iris Olivia has shown enough to suggest she can win at this level, having placed on the all-weather on her last couple of outings. That said, BLING offered plenty of encouragement when fifth at Newbury on her introduction. Hugo Palmer's filly showed up well for a long way before weakening in the closing stages and the runner-up has since boosted that form. ATR VERDICT: Noble Horizon struggled at Hamilton, but his second at Glorious Goodwood reads well and he must be respected as a result. Even so, HOLLYWELL STREAM is fancied to negate a wide draw and get back on the winning trail. Jane Chapple-Hyam's filly found only a progressive rival too strong at Haydock having struck at Newmarket the start prior, and a further 2lb rise might still underestimate her. Others to note include Be Patient and Per Contra.
