ATR VERDICT: Testing ground conditions might hold the key to RHODES RUNNER as evidenced in a Chester novice recently. Ralph Beckett's filly has yet to make much of an impact in nurseries but it could be different this time and she's fancied to repel the challenge of Blondie Larry, for whom an opening mark of 73 looks fair. Stable companion Knock Three Times (fourth) was less than a length in arrears of Perigord Noir (third) at Bath, and the former could find some improvement for the addition of first-time cheekpieces.

ATR VERDICT: Despite the burden of a 5lb penalty, it is quite difficult to oppose the Stan Moore-trained CALL TIME. Jack Nicholls dropped his whip at a crucial stage over 6f but still managed to galvanise his mount, who got up in the nick of time. Bama Lama and Snow Day have something to prove at present so Some Nightmare and Outer Edge, who have both chased home the in-form Macarone (runs in the 1.19), look the only logical dangers.

ATR VERDICT: Two miles on a softer surface could stretch the stamina of some, and it may pay to side with Sir Mark Prescott's CAMPEONA. She's a distance winner and finished third in a better race at Kempton last time out when possibly left with too much to do. If she fails to make the most of the drop in grade, then four-time hurdle winner and Flat handicap debutant No Ordinary Joe could take advantage upped in trip, followed by Chester winner Carthusian.
