ATR VERDICT: Having made the perfect start for new connections at Thirsk recently, MO ANAM CHARA could be poised to follow up. The three-year-old scored with enough in hand to suggest that a 7lb higher mark is surmountable and she gets the vote over the downgraded Imperial Guard. Michael Dods' inmate is only 2lb higher than when completing a hat-trick at Ayr in late July and could prove dangerous if performing to his best. Last month's C&D winner Black Storm completes the shortlist.
